General Manager informed council that he is still waiting for the approval for the Interpretation Center. In regards to Gaba Holding, many lots were sold and the construction will be starting soon. He also informed council that the Caisse from St-Louis is requesting a reduction on the water and sewerage taxes due on the late property of Radio Shack.
